



From Vienna Airport to City Centre

The Vienna International Airport (VIE) in “Schwechat” is served by all major airline networks. The services are every 30 minutes available. From the Vienna Airport you can either take

- the regular train (“S-Bahn”) no. S7 to station “Landstraße/Wien Mitte” (Direction „Wien Floridsdorf)
- the ÖBB Railjet to main train station “Wien Hauptbahnhof”
- the express train CAT (“City Airport Train”) to station “Landstraße/Wien Mitte”
- the Vienna Airport Lines (bus) to station “Schwedenplatz”
- a taxicab.

Travel time to/from the airport to the centre of Vienna, and TU Wien is approximately 40 minutes. **Please note** that in some cases it is required to validate your tickets before boarding.

Vienna’s public transport rail network:

- **Red arrow:** Vienna Airport (where you e.g. may take the CAT – City Airport Train to the City Centre)
- **Black arrow:** terminal stop of the CAT at “Landstraße” (where you may take the metro U4 to station “Karlsplatz”)
- **Green arrow:** metro station “Karlsplatz” (where the TU Wien main building is located)
- **Blue arrow:** marks the event location.
